This is a one set. Notice how the ball is just coming out of Nicole's hands and Nikki #15 is jumping at the same time, ready to hit the ball.

The Middle That Gets Blocked

The ball is coming to Lauren and she is ready to set. You can see the RS and M anticipating the set from Lauren. Lauren's arms are neutral and you can't tell where she is going to set the ball.



The ball is in Lauren's hands and she has created a gap between the M and the OH for CU.



It appears that this could be a set to the M or the back row hitters.



The set is to the middle and the CU middle jumps up to block.





Here the hitter is hitting against one blocker. This is a close up of the previous picture.

There's a huge gap between CU's middle and OH but the set to the middle is stuffed!
